Day One

Did you know that approximately 40% of America's population can trace their ancestry through Ellis Island? We'll also have time to stop for photos at the Statue of Liberty, a gift from France which was dedicated in 1886. Dinner this evening is at a **family friendly restaurant** in **Little Italy**. After dinner, we'll travel up the **Empire State Building** for a fantastic view of the city.

Day Three

Our last morning starts with breakfast before a **driving tour** of **Harlem**. Our next stop will be at **Grant's Tomb**, overlooking the Hudson River. Enjoy a **boxed lunch** today before taking a **walking tour** of **Central Park**, one of the most famous parks in America. Stop at **Strawberry Fields**, the John Lennon memorial site, the richly ornamented **Bethesda Terrace**, and **Belvedere Castle**, the second highest natural elevation in the park.
